Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Kununurra Picture Gardens would like to advise the community that in response to the Coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak and with respect to restrictions on public gatherings.

Being an outdoor venue, KPG anticipate opening as normal, however, there will be some changes to how we operate to ensure we adhere to Government advice.

HYGIENE AND CLEANLINESS

Cleaning processes for our public facilities and high touch areas will be increased to ensure the highest level of hygiene. Soap and hand sanitiser will be available.

NO CASH - We ask movie goers to please pay by Eftpos only, using tap and go or inserting the card. Please note, cards **MUST** have a microchip to work with our Eftpos facility, debit cards without a microchip will not work sorry.

KIOSK CLOSED - To assist minimising risk to the public the kiosk will remain closed until advice from the Government changes.

We ask, as always, that guests clean any space they use at KPG and dispose of rubbish in the bins provided or take rubbish with them.

SOCIAL DISTANCING

To abide by the Government advice on social distancing we ask guests to stay in or near their cars and tune into the radio station to hear the movie.

People wishing to sit outside of their cars are asked to maintain the recommended social distance - one person per 4 square metres.
